Web Browsers for the Atari

Now you can use your Atari to browse the web, including our site. There are three packages you can use. One is WWWxxx.ZIP (xxx is the version number). This package was released in October and works in monochrome and color. While it's definitely in the early stages, it is undergoing daily revision. To get the latest version of this package, go to ftp://ftp.toad.net/pub/atarist/internet/www_latest.zip. Linux for the Atari 68030 machines is also available now, and you can run the Chimera (graphical) or LYNX (text-based) browsers from there. You can also use MiNT & MiNTNet to run these very same browsers. But the WWWxxx.ZIP package seems to be the simplest.

STacy Portable: The Atari STacy is a complete, portable system. It is a favorite machine for musicians. It includes a built in trackball, a floppy drive, a hard disk, and a monochrome LCD supertwist display. It uses a special version of TOS 1.04 and can usually support expansions such as the ICD AdSpeed ST accelerator and the AT-Speed PC Emulator. Includes MIDI ports, serial and parallel ports, and mouse/joystick ports.



1040STE Series: Defining Computer Flexibility

The 1040STE is the ultimately upgradeable Atari computer. Add SIMMs, throw in an accelerator, go to TOS 2.06. It all works and works well, because the STE is the only machine in the ST series that was designed with upgradeablility in mind. The 1040STE was introduced in 1990 and has stereo sound, TOS 1.60 (later 1.62), and a 720k floppy drive. We can upgrade the floppy drives in these machines to 1.44mb. Essentially, the STE is the same as the 1040STF that preceded it except for its sound capabilities, expanded 4096 color palette, and its SIMM memory upgradeability. 1040STE's have become available periodically and always sell out fast. If you're interested in one of these highly versatile machines, please be sure to let us know. Mega STE: The Mega STE has a 16 MHz, cached 68000 processor, with a slot for an optional 68881 math coprocessor. It was shipped in two versions – first with TOS 2.05 and a 720k floppy drive, and the later with TOS 2.06 and a 1.44mb floppy drive. Older machines may be upgraded. It has one VME card slot for expansion (great for video cards) and can support one standard half-

height 3.5" SCSI hard disk drive when used with the optional internal host adapter. Includes cartridge port, MIDI ports, stereo out jacks, three serial ports, one parallel port, and one LocalTalk LAN port. Up to 4mb RAM using SIMMs. Works with any ST monitor. First ST to include NewDesk desktop. A new machine with 4MB of RAM is just \$1029.95. Detachable keyboard is Mega ST & TT compatible.

TT030: The TT030 is an ideal graphics workstation and can use up to 266mb of RAM. It runs a cached 32MHz 68030 processor with a 68882 math coprocessor.
