Ingredients: 14 1/2 oz Chicken broth, can; 1 c Broccoli, frozen, cut; 1 c Mushrooms, fresh, sliced; 1/2 c Onion, chopped; 1 T Margarine; 2 T Flour, all-purpose; 13 1/2 oz Evaporated skim milk, can; 8 oz Corn, whole kernal; 1 T Pimiento, chopped; 1/4 t Salt; 1/8 t Pepper

In a small saucepan bring broth and broccoli to boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 5 minutes. Do not drain. Set aside. In a large saucepan cook mushrooms and onions in margarine till tender. Ingredients: 1/2 c Soy sauce; 1/2 c Orange juice; 1/4 c Catsup; 1/4 c Chopped fresh parsley; 2 T Lemon juice; 1/3 T Ground pepper; 2 x Cloves minced garlic; 6 x Shark steaks, or 6 x Swordfish or salmon steaks

Directions: Combine soy sauce, orange juice, catsup, chopped parsley, lemon juice, pepper, and minced garlic. Add fish; cover and marinate in refrigerator for 2 hours. Remove fish from marinade, reserving marinade. Grill fish over hot coals 6 minutes on each side or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork, basting frequently with marinade.

Tanya's Chocolate Chip Cheesecake

Ingredients: 30 Oreo Cookies; 3 Tbs. Butter; 4 8 oz pks cream cheese; 14 oz sweetened condensed milk; 4 eggs 2 tsp. vanilla; 12 oz chocolate chips

Directions: Crush oreos, mix with butter and press into a 9" springform pan. Beat cream cheese until fluffy, beat in milk until smooth. Add egg and vanilla, mix well. Melt 1/2 C chips, cool, mix into 1/2 C batter. Stir 1 C chips into remaining batter, pour into crust. Marble chocolate-batter mix into cake. Sprinkle top with remaining 1/2 C chips. Bake 1 hour at 400 degrees F.


