
The Eleven Most Commonly Asked Questions *regarding* **LANTastic[®] and Windows[®] 95**

1. Do LANTastic 6.0 and LANTastic Power Suite work with Windows 95?

Yes. LANTastic 6.0 and LANTastic Power Suite have been tested and documented for operation with some limitations on systems running in the Windows 95 environment. Artisoft has also worked closely with its customers and resellers, and has determined that LANTastic will operate on Windows 95 systems under most circumstances. We are aware of several configuration-dependent compatibility issues involved with running in the Windows 95 environment (such as incompatibilities encountered with certain hardware configurations, print drivers, disk drivers, and intermittent memory errors when printing graphics or large fonts). These are largely due to LANTastic running on Windows 95 in DOS emulation mode.

We have provided a tested and documented LANTastic 32-bit Client for Windows 95, which directly addresses these issues. This software is available to all LANTastic, LANTastic Power Suite and Simply LANTastic customers at no charge from our World Wide Web server, BBS, Artisoft's CompuServe Forum or FTP server. LANTastic 32-bit Client for Windows 95 will provide users adding Windows 95 platforms to their LANTastic networks or migrating existing LANTastic workstations to Windows 95 with complete, 32-bit client access to computer resources on their LANTastic networks. A new product, LANTastic for Windows 95, including complete 32-bit client and server capabilities, will be available in early 1996.

Documentation is available today for setting up LANTastic 6.0 or LANTastic Power Suite on Windows 95 platforms. You can download it from our World Wide Web server, BBS, Artisoft's CompuServe Forum, FTP server or FaxReturn system. 2. When is LANTastic for Windows 95 going to be available?

LANTastic for Windows 95, with complete 32-bit client and server capabilities, will be available in early 1996.

3. What new features are going to be in LANTastic for Windows 95?

In early January, Artisoft will start shipping the new LANTastic for Windows 95 network operating system, a 32-bit client and server version of the award-winning LANTastic system. LANTastic for Windows 95 will allow Artisoft customers to easily integrate the power and performance of Windows 95 PCs into their existing LANTastic networks. The LANTastic software will also allow users to create a single, cohesive network from Windows 95, Windows, DOS, OS/2[®] and a variety of Intel[®] hardware platforms.

A unique feature of the LANTastic for Windows 95 system is that it lets users on Windows 95 PCs access and share files, CD-ROMs and printers with DOS-, Windows-, or OS/2-based PCs on a LANTastic network. In addition to this, LANTastic for Windows 95 has enhanced features for network administration, security and the network user's interface.

A new network administration feature lets users view and add groups and users from a central screen with less navigating through the network. It also includes a template feature, in which a profile of user attributes is created once for applying later as needed for individuals. This increases the network administrator's productivity. Also new to the network administration is enhanced security with four new levels of access for supervisors. This feature provides different levels of access, depending on whether the supervisor needs low, middle or top access and management privileges within the network.

Current LANtastic customers will find a familiar yet updated user interface in LANtastic for Windows 95, that integrates well with the Windows 95 desktop and feature set. The LANtastic for Windows 95 system includes a new LANtastic Custom Control Panel, which lets users customize tabs and buttons, displaying as much or as little information as they want. Users can change settings to suit their needs for color, tab names, icons and applications, all from the Control Panel. Plus, they can drag and drop up to 100 different application icons onto 16 user-definable tabbed pages, and set password protection for each page. Through the Custom Control Panel, Artisoft's value-added resellers can incorporate their logos or company information into "about" screens, and add their applications or utilities to provide a custom solution for the end user.

LANtastic for Windows 95 will be available as: software-only kits for one, five, 10 and 25 users; two-user starter kits that include software, two network interface cards and cable; and add-on kits with software, a network interface card and cable. Pricing, which will be set approximately 30 days before the product ships, is expected to be less than the current \$119 (MSRP) for a single-user, software-only version of the LANtastic 6.0 network operating system.

Value-added resellers will be able to preview LANtastic for Windows 95 at Artisoft's 24-city LANtastic Reseller Alliance Tour from Oct. 12 through Nov. 7.

4. Will upgrades or conversions be available?

Special offers for current LANtastic, LANtastic Power Suite and Simply LANtastic customers who are migrating their PCs to Windows 95 will be made as soon as LANtastic for Windows 95 pricing is formally announced, approximately 30 days before the product ships. As an immediate, first step in the migration process, our LANtastic 32-bit Client for Windows 95 software is being offered to licensed customers free of charge from our World Wide Web server, BBS, Artisoft's CompuServe Forum and FTP server. This software will provide LANtastic users running Windows 95 platforms with complete, 32-bit client access to all other resources on their LANtastic network.

5. At what prices will the new software sell for?

Pricing, will be set approximately 30 days before the product ships.

6. Should I hold off buying LANtastic 6.0 or LANtastic Power Suite?

Absolutely not. In fact, we're making a special offer to customers who've recently purchased LANtastic 6.0 or LANtastic Power Suite. If you buy LANtastic 6.0 or LANtastic Power Suite before December 15, 1995 you'll receive a special promotional offer on LANtastic for Windows 95. So hold on to your sales receipt, make sure that you've registered your copy of LANtastic and watch your mailbox for more information. LANtastic 32-bit Client for Windows 95 software is available to licensed LANtastic customers, free of charge on our World Wide Web server, BBS or FTP servers, so you don't need to wait to migrate to Windows 95 with LANtastic.

7. What hardware do you recommend to run LANtastic or LANtastic Power Suite with Windows 95?

Our tests indicate that small and growing businesses running with Windows 95 need more memory than the recommended memory requirements specified by Microsoft. For any LANtastic client, we recommend using at least a 386DX33 processor with 8MB RAM minimum. For any LANtastic server, we recommend at least a 486DX33 processor with 16MB RAM minimum. LANtastic for Windows 95 and LANtastic 32-bit Client software products are designed to work with the adapter drivers supplied with Windows 95. If you're using an Artisoft NodeRunner card, we recommend that you configure it to run in NE1000-compatible mode.

8. What other Artisoft products are supported and tested under Windows 95?

LANtastic 32-bit Client, LANtastic 6.0 and LANtastic Power Suite are the three products tested, documented and supported by Artisoft on Windows 95 platforms. No other Artisoft products will be supported or tested for use specifically on Windows 95 platforms. However, most other Artisoft products running on DOS, Windows and OS/2 platforms will interoperate with Windows 95 platforms running with LANtastic 32-bit Client for Windows 95, LANtastic 6.0 or LANtastic Power Suite. The chart below highlights the interoperability of LANtastic and other Artisoft products with Windows 95 platforms under most circumstances.

* ArtiCom modem sharing software can be used with Windows 95 as it would normally be used with Windows 3.x with the following exceptions:

1. A Windows 95 machine can't be a modem server and a modem client at the same time.
2. A Windows 95 modem server can't activate any DOS applications or open a DOS prompt when the modem is being accessed.

9. How does LANtastic for Windows 95 compare to the native networking features in Windows 95?

Award-winning LANtastic is the only network solution specifically designed for small and growing businesses. With more than 3.5 million users worldwide, LANtastic is the most popular network for small business because of its easy-to-use interface, intuitive administration tools, reliability, scalability and security. A unique feature of LANtastic for Windows 95 is its ability to share the computer resources that are attached to DOS-based PCs running LANtastic.

LANtastic is designed with comprehensive built-in security features typically found only on sophisticated network servers such as the Microsoft® NT Server or Novell® NetWare®. LANtastic is the most adaptable network software for growing, mixed environments of DOS, Windows, OS/2 and Windows 95 platforms. LANtastic users on Windows 95 platforms can access resources attached to existing DOS systems, a feature that Microsoft networking products don't have. And, we're adding new features that will make administration and management of cohesive, mixed platform environments even easier and more effective.

In early 1996, we'll release LANtastic for Windows 95, which Artisoft has designed to optimize Windows 95 features, and which will include full 32-bit client and server networking. LANtastic will continue to offer its hallmark ease of use, excellent security and scalability. It will also provide a drag-and-drop user interface, cohesive integration with DOS, Windows, OS/2 and Windows 95 platforms, and facilitate easy connectivity to existing Microsoft® and Novell® networks.

LANtastic's product design provides a solid foundation for added power, performance and function. Microsoft is positioning Windows 95 as a low-end, desktop solution with network connectivity and NT as their business networking solution. As a result, Windows 95 doesn't include three key features that small and growing businesses need: performance, scalability and security. In contrast, we've planned for LANtastic functionality to include Apple Macintosh client-server capabilities. We're developing a new, advanced file system technology that will offer very efficient disk space utilization and fast, reliable performance that we expect will rival NT Server or NetWare file system performance.

These capabilities will provide small businesses with an easy-to-use, affordable, reliable and powerful network that will grow with them and their growing business network demands. There's no need move to Microsoft's more complex, sophisticated Window NT Server or Novell's NetWare product lines when high performance, security and network growth are key network requirements because LANtastic networks have all these features. And with LANtastic networking, users can continue to use their existing investments in DOS, Windows and OS/2 platforms, while growing their businesses and networks.

10. Will Simply LANtastic, LANtastic Home Network or LANtastic 5.0 run on Windows 95?

Simply LANtastic, LANtastic Home Network and LANtastic 5.0 aren't supported on platforms running Windows 95. Customers using Simply LANtastic, Home Network or LANtastic 5.0 who are migrating to Windows 95 should download LANtastic 32-bit Client for Windows 95, which will be available free of charge, on October 17 from Artisoft's World Wide Web server, Artisoft's CompuServe Forum, BBS or FTP server. This software will provide Windows 95 platforms with complete, 32-bit client access to all other resources on their LANtastic network. Users must have at least one machine on the network running LANtastic 6.0, LANtastic Power Suite, Simply LANtastic or Home Network as a server in order for the network to function.

Artisoft is offering special promotions on LANtastic for Windows 95 to current LANtastic users who purchased LANtastic 6.0 or LANtastic Power Suite, Simply LANtastic and Home Network between August 24 and December 15, 1995.

11. How can I receive technical assistance for Artisoft products used with Windows 95?

If you have problems using Artisoft products with Windows 95, call any of Artisoft's Priority Support services. These services are available Monday through Friday, 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Saturday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.. Mountain Time, excluding holidays. There's no waiting, and the cost is \$2.50 per minute.

If you prefer the cost to be billed to your phone number, call Priority 900 Support at 900-555-TECH (8324). This service is available only in the United States.

If you prefer the cost to be billed to VISA, MasterCard or American Express, call Priority Support at 800 293-3936. Priority 800 Support is available in the United States and Canada.
